대덕의 대표축제

금강로하스축제 (4월)

대청호반 천혜의 자연 속에서 온 가족이 함께 힐링할 수 있는 곳. 지역 축제를 넘어 전 국민이 참가하는 문화관광형 전국 대표 축제이다. 가족, 건강, 취미를 기본 테마로 50여 개의 프로그램, 체험부스 등 다채로운 공연이 펼쳐진다.

동춘당 문화제(4월)

우암 송시열 선생과 함께 양승으로 불린 동춘당 송준길 선생의 사상과 업적을 기리는 것이다. 화호 대회, 전통차 시음, 전통문화 체험 등 다채로운 프로그램이 준비되어 있으며 동춘당 선생의 시호봉송 행렬 체험은 어느 곳에서든 쉽게 접할 수 없는 축제의 백미다.

계족산 맨발축제(5월)

14.5km의 숲 속 황톳길을 맨발로 걷고 달리는 전 세계 유일의 맨발문화 축제이다. 숲 속에서 축제와 함께 진행되는 맨발(Fun Fun) 클래식 공연을 통해 자연의 아름다움과 문화예술의 감동을 느낄 수 있다.

장동계족산 코스모스 축제(10월)

바람에 하늘거리는 코스모스 길에서 여유로운 하루를 즐겨보자. 전통과 고유의 정취를 느낄 수 있는 코스모스 축제는 화려한 무대행사, 전라북도 꽃물들이 체험 등 볼거리와 즐길 거리가 풍부하다.

대청호마라톤대회(10월)

대청호반의 수려한 풍광 아래 펼쳐지는 대덕구의 대표적 행사이다. 건강코스 5km와 미니코스 10km, 하프코스 21.0975km 부분으로 진행되며 중부권 지역 내에 가장 많은 인원이 참여하는 마라톤 대회이다.

Major Festivals
in Daedeok

Geumgang LOHAS Festival (April)

The Geumgang River LOHAS Festival by the Daechongho Lake is a place where the whole family can enjoy a time of renewal. More than just a local event, the festival is a recognized cultural celebration in Korea that attracts tourists from all parts of the country. Under the basic themes of family, health, and hope, this festival features about 50 programs, event booths, and diverse performances.

Dongchundang Cultural Festival (April)

The Dongchundang Cultural Festival is a venue that pays tribute to the thoughts and achievements of "Jum" Song Shi-yeol and "Dongchundang" Song Jung-il, who are often considered to be the "Two Great Confucian Scholars from the Song Clan". The festival features a wide range of programs such as painting competition, tasting traditional tea, and traditional wedding performance. In particular, you can enjoy a special event that cannot be found anywhere else but here: the reenacted version of the parade for granting the posthumous epithet to Dongchundang.

Gyeongju Mountain Bare Foot Festival (May)

The Gyeongju Mountain Bare Foot Festival is the world's one and only festival where participants walk or run barefoot through a 14.5 km red clay trail in a forest. One of the events held in the forest along with the festival, "Fun Fun Classical Music Concert", will offer you a precious chance to feel touched by the beauty of nature, art, and culture.

Jangdong Gyeongju Mountain Cosmos Festival (October)

The Jangdong Gyeongju Mountain Cosmos Festival is an opportunity to spend a relaxing time strolling along the trail where the cosmos trembles in a soft breeze. The festival is filled with a variety of events that will make you reminisce about your hometown, such as fantastic stage performances, traditional games, and dyeing your fingernails with flowers.

Daechongho Lake Marathon (October)

The Daechongho Lake Marathon is a representative event of Daedeok-gu that takes place along the beautiful scenery of Daechongho Lake. Participants can choose from four courses: the health course (5 km), the mini-course (10 km), the half marathon (21.0975 km), and the full marathon. The Daechongho Lake Marathon attracts the largest number of participants in the central region of Korea.

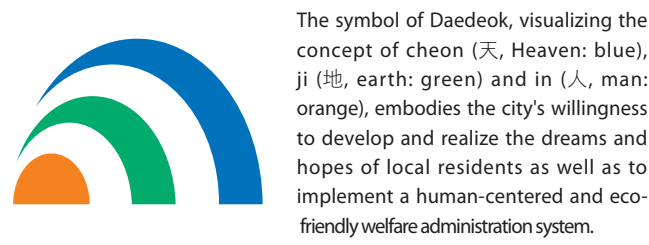

Daedeok-gu is a rich repository of clean, natural resources such as Gyejoksan Mountain, the lifeline to the residents in Daejeon that is visible from anywhere in Daejeon, and the Daecheongho Lake. Daedeok-gu also serves as a center for revitalizing the economy of Daejeon since it is where the Daejeon Industrial Complex and the Daedeok Industrial Complex are located. Throughout history, Daedeok has produced many scholars, patriots, and virtuous women who showed filial piety to their parents and parents-in-law and remained chaste after their husbands died. It is the birthplace of the spiritual culture in Hanbat, the original name of Daejeon because it has a variety of tangible and intangible cultural heritages including the Hoedeokhyanggyo Local Confucian School, the Dongchundang House, and the Gyejok Fortress.

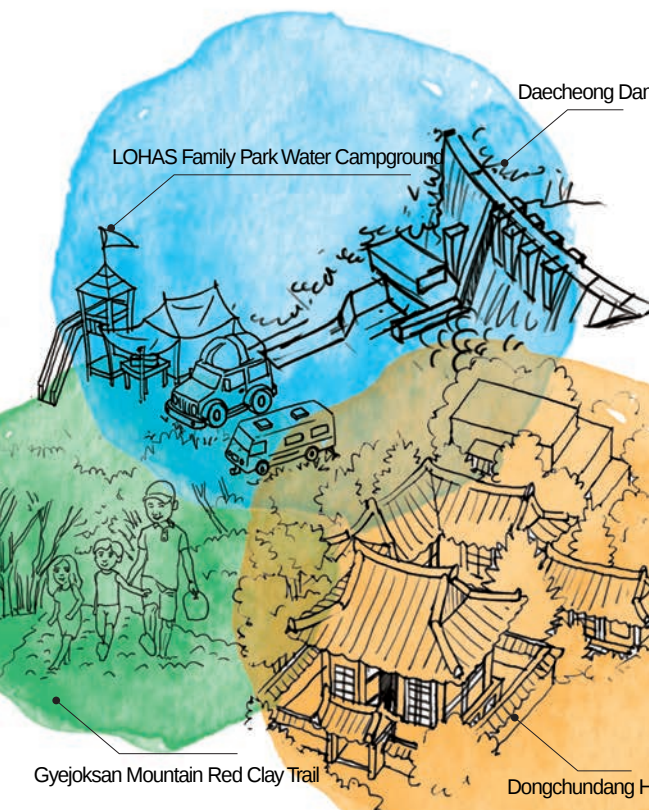

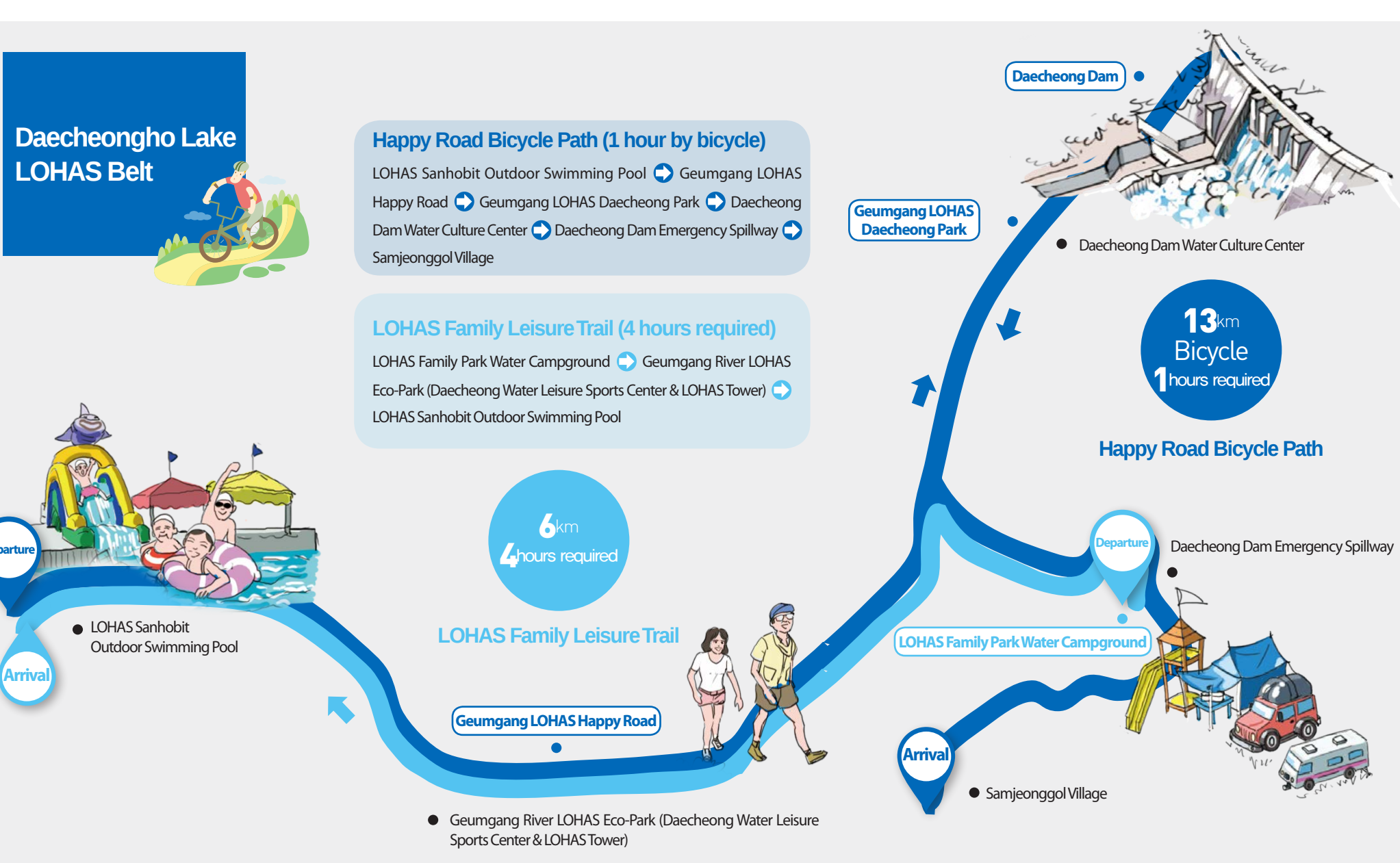

Gyejoksan Mountain Eco-Healing Bel

Red Clay Trail Embracing Virtues (2 hours required)

The Gyejoksan Mountain Red Clay Trail connects to the "Trail Embracing Virtues", one of the "Green Trails with Stories", providing the experience of eco-healing in the 1,000 years of history of Daedeok.

Gyejoksan Mountain Red Clay Trail

Gyejoksan Mountain Red Clay Trail is the first trail in Korea to apply the healthy living concept of walking barefoot along a forest path. In 2006 it was selected as one of the "33 Places Making Me Want to Return" by travel journalists. The trail is covered with soft Hwangto, which means red clay in Korean. A therapeutic walk in the thick forest provides visitors with a relaxing foot massage. Leave for Gyejoksan Mountain and walk barefoot along the red clay path in a forest full of fresh-scented air.

Jewoldang Villa and Ogojae

Jewoldang Villa is a separate building where Song Gyu-yeom, who served as a civil servant during the Joseon Dynasty, lived and tutored younger scholars upon abandoning his high government position after Queen Inhyeon was disposed and forced into exile. Ogojae (situated on the northern face of the Jewoldang Villa with a dividing wall) is a building on which Song, Sang Gi, son of Song Gyu-yeom, hung a signboard carved with his pseudonym "Ogo".

Traditional Markets in Daedeok

Ojeong Agricultural and Fishery Products Wholesale Market

Founded in 1986, the Ojeong Agricultural and Fishery Products Wholesale Market is the oldest wholesale market in Daejeon. It is located near the Gyeongbu - Honam Expressway, which makes it easy to reach and fresh products directly delivered from local producers. It operates an agro-fishery inspection center on site that is open for 24 hours a day to guarantee the safety and freshness of the foods.

Jungni Traditional Market

With 35 years of history and tradition, the Jungni Traditional Market has 213 stores. You can find fresh local agro-fishery products and a range of daily necessities. The market specializes in trading local products and highlighting the characteristics of the region by planning a variety of events, including a night market.

Sintarjin 5th-day Market

The Sintarjin 5th-day Market is a traditional market on the Geumgang River that has a permanent market and a regularly held market. You can find the 5th-day market on the dates ending with 3 and 8 along with the permanent market, which has 122 stores. Because the market is located in a convenient place with high accessibility, you can easily find special products from all over the country.

Beopdong Traditional Market

The Beopdong Traditional Market has about 50 stores that create a friendly atmosphere among the modern surroundings of residential apartments. It is also a uniquely environmental-friendly and customer-oriented market because for the first time in Daejeon, a Green Environment Solar Power Unit was installed to generate electricity.

Jungni Happy Flea Market (April - June / September - October)

The Jungni Happy Flea Market encourages more than 6,000 local residents to sell or exchange secondhand goods. Voluntary donations totaling more than 10 million KRW are used to help those in need. In both name and reality, it has become the largest and most renowned flea market in the central region of Korea.
